


THE PROFESSIONAL GIG ECONOMY VALUES EXPERIENCE

- The professional gig economy values experience - skill levels, education & years of experience determine fees
- On Flexing It® the median income earned by consultants increases by 120% between 5-10 years of experience (INR 6800 per day) vs. 15-20 years of experience (INR 15000 per day).
- Till 10-15 years of experience, median income grows at a higher rate than that at the 75th and 90th percentile ; this trend reverses from the 10-15 to 15-20 experience bracket



QUALITY IS A KEY DIFFERENTIATOR IN FEE LEVELS ACROSS THE TOP SKILLS

Consultants Fees at the Median, 75th, and 90th Percentile for Top Skills in Demand (5-10 years of experience)




The 'quality' of a consultant's experience i.e. education, prior organisations & positive client feedback, significantly impacts fees earned

For IT/Technology and Marketing, the quality of experience makes the most difference in formative years (<10 years), with a significant difference between median compensation and 75th percentile/90th percentile

Information Technology is the highest paying skill for Junior Consultants <5 years of experience (median per diem fees of INR 6500 and those in the 90th percentile commanding INR 28000)

Consultant Fees at the Median, 75th, and 90th Percentile for Top Skills in demand (10-15 years of experience)




 Information Technology and Strategy are the highest paying skills for consultants with 10-15 years of experience

 The most significant difference in fees at different percentiles at the mid management level is for HR consultants - 100% jump in fees for HR from the 75th percentile and the 90th percentile



TOP-TIER EXPERIENCED STRATEGY CONSULTANTS COMMAND 4X+ FEES COMPARED WITH THE MEDIAN

Consultants Fees at the Median, 75th, and 90th Percentile for Top Skills in Demand (15-20 years of experience)



 Even at higher experience levels, Strategy & IT Consultants charge the highest median fee

For a strategy consultant with 15-20 years, the per day fees range from INR 15000 (median level) to INR 61600 (90th percentile) - a 311% increase - based on the quality of experience

 Even for other skills, quality of experience can yield 2.5 – 3X higher fees





THE CONSULTING AND PHARMA INDUSTRY PAY THE HIGHEST FEES TO FREELANCE CONSULTANTS



- Consulting and Healthcare & Pharma pay the highest fees
- Median fees range from INR12,000- INR 15,000 across industries but grow at a faster pace for Consulting and Healthcare & Pharma as compared to FMCG and Development sector as we move to the 75th and 90th percentile





The Gender Pay Gap persists in freelance work

- freelancers


• 35% lower median income earned by women

• Though the median compensation of women is significantly lower, it grows at a relatively higher rate than that of men until 15-20 years of experience. However, it stagnates at this point while that of men continues to grow.

• At 20+ years experience, while men's median income rose by 20% (18000 from 15,000) for women, it remained the same at 12,000.

Impact of COVID

Median Fee (in INR per day)



- slowly reaching the pre-COVID levels.
- Q1 and Q2 of 2020.



• The median fee earned by freelance consultants dropped by almost 25% between Q1 and Q2 of 2020 but started picking up Q3 onwards-

In FMCG, consultants were least impacted by the pandemic while in other industries, including Professional Services, Pharmaceuticals, and Education, there was a 20% drop in median compensation between

• The impact of the pandemic on junior consultants (< 5 years of experience) was limited and their earnings were relatively unaffected.
